1	Under 10's play with a size 5 ball.
2	Shinguards are required for all players.
3	Both goalposts and the crossbar must have the same width and depth.
4	A ball on top of the touch line is out of play (in touch)
5	The player substituted must leave the field at the half way line.
6	The ball is considered “in play” when any part of it is on or above the touchline or goal line.
7	A goal can be scored from the kickoff.
8	Players are allowed to wear “medical alert” bracelets.
9	If the ball strikes the corner flag and rebounds into the field it is considered “out of play”.
10	A goal may be scored directly from a corner kick.
11	Only “deliberate” handling of the ball should be punished.
12	Holding an opponent is a direct free kick.
13	The ball must strike the back of the net in order to count as a goal.
14	When the referee must stop play due to an injury he/she restarts play with a “drop ball”.
15	There are five offenses that warrants sending off a player.
16	A referee signals a direct free kick by raising his/her arm straight above their head.
17	A goal may be scored directly from a throw-in.
18	Assistant Referees’ signals are for the players.
19	You cannot be “offside” on a throw-in.
20	The minimum number of players to start an 11v11 match is 7.
