- Reviews and recommends financial policies to the board,
- Oversees budget preparation and financial planning
- Ensures that accurate, timely, and meaningful financial statements are prepared and presented to the board
- Presents to the president for his/her consideration, the names of capable people willing and available to serve as the chairperson and as committee members on the audit committee
- Reviews the annual audit and, having assessed its contents, make recommendations to the board
- Ensures that accurate and complete financial records are maintained
- Safeguards the organization's assets
- Ensures that the organization has the proper risk-management provisions in place
- Helps the full board understand the organization's financial affairs
- Ensures compliance with federal, state, and other requirements related to the organization's finances
